PLEASE FIND ATTACHED A MESSAGE FROM DIAKOV IN WHICH HE CONVEYS A REQUEST FROM MIKHAILOV TO PROVIDE VISA SUPPORT FOR ZELENTSOV TO REPLACE VOSHININ AS THE MINISTRY OF DEFENSE REPRESENTATIVE TO THE WORKSHOP. COULD YOU SEND THIS SUPPORT WITH TELEXES TO MICHAILOV AND DIAKOV AND A FAX TO KORTUNOV? ALSO, PLEASE NOTIFY THE STATE DEPARTMENT.

DIAKOV'S MESSAGE ALSO INDICATES THAT MIKHAILOV WANTS TO TALK TO NUCKOLLS ABOUT WARHEAD DISMANTLEMENT.

I RECEIVED A MESSAGE ON MY ANSWERING MACHINES FROM DEVOLPI YESTERDAY WHO SAID THAT "THE SHIT HAS HIT THE FAN" AND ALLESSI'S OFFICE IS TRYING TO INTIMIDATE LAB PARTICIPANTS OUT OF COMING TO THE WORKSHOP. THEY ARE DEMANDING A LIST OF LAB PARTICIPANTS AND CLAIM THAT, SINCE BUSH'S SPEECH, OUR WORKSHOP "IS AGAINST NATIONAL POLICY." I WONDER WHETHER THEY WILL TRY TO HEAD OFF THE SOVIET DELEGATION.

WHEN IS TOM LEAVING FOR CASTILLENCELLO? ALEX APPARENTLY LEFT YESTERDAY.

DIAKOV ALSO CONVEYED MIKHAILOV'S APPROVAL FOR THE PRESS BRIEFING. I CAN'T IMAGINE KORTUNOV NOT APPROVING. LETS THEREFORE GO AHEAD WITH PLANS. CAN WE DO IT AT THE HOTEL, 10-11 AM ON FRIDAY?
